REFOCUS 2nd Multiplier Event successfully concludes in Madrid, Spain

On March 10, 2025, REFOCUS (REthinking and FOstering Competence and skills for sUustainable transport, Shipping, and logistics) project successfully hosted its 2nd Multiplier Event in Madrid, Spain, bringing together a diverse group of stakeholders, including policymakers, faculty, industry experts, and rights-holders such as young people, women, and environmental and human rights defenders.

The event, held at cambiaMO, focused on co-designing a curriculum responsive to contemporary societal and planetary needs, emphasizing an inclusive, participatory, and accountable process for a people-centered just transition. The day began with a networking session, followed by an interactive session facilitated by experts across three key topics: Climate Literacy, Just Transition, and the Barriers and Drivers in new curricula implementation. These discussions, held in a Challenge Clinique format, encouraged dynamic exchanges and collaborative problem-solving.

A highlight of the event was the roundtable dialogue on "Just Transition from Reality to Academia," which explored bridging the gap between academic theories and real-world sustainability challenges. The event concluded with a networking aperitif, providing participants with the opportunity to connect and share insights on advancing climate literacy and sustainability practices.
